The Salmon River flows through Riggins with jet boat races and river rafting in the spring and summer. Some of the best hunting in Idaho takes place here. Riggins is an outdoor and sportsman paradise.

Our close-knit congregation includes individuals with diverse backgrounds and experience. This is a part-time position and will require the selected Pastor to be bi-vocational. The church will provide a monthly salary and a parsonage that has 3 bedrooms and 3 1/2 baths with an office plus detached 2 car garage.
